Should you be shortlisted for a scholarship you will be asked at that stage to sit the appropriate English language test. However, if you already have test scores you can enter them here. You will not be disadvantaged if you have not sat the test when you apply.

Candidates who are selected for a scholarship will need to provide evidence of International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) scores which are no more than 24 months old and meet the minimum requirement for entry into their preferred programme of study.

As a general rule, for those wishing to complete a postgraduate qualification an overall IELTS score of 6.5 and no band less than 6.0 is the minimum required.


